
## Pupil Premium What is it? Why Do we get it? What do we spend it on? What Is the Impact?

From September 2014 all children of Infant age were eligible for a FSM.

- Support with our curriculum-

maths and learning resources
- Development of Boosting Reading

progress
- Improving technology and  
opportunities for children to use  
the latest software and equipment
- Social and emotional support  
through nurture groups, time to  
talk and direct work with the  
children.
- Support with Trips and activities
- Offer of clubs after school– such  
as football, club energy and tennis
- Pets as therapy—a programme to  
grow more confident readers



## How can Pupil Premium help your children?

Folly Hill Infant School receives additional funding to help children who are entitled to receive Free School Meals or have been in the last 6 years, children who are Looked After by the local authority or who come from Service Families.

The Funding is called **Pupil Premium** and we use it to help children make good progress at school. Current data shows that in our school, children whom are given pupil premium funding do as well as all the other children. Schools are free to spend the Pupil Premium as they see fit. However we will be held accountable for how we have used the additional funding to support pupils from low-income families.

## EVALUATION AND IMPROVEMENTS

Everything we do for the children at Folly Hill Infant School to try to boost outcomes and narrow the gaps in their learning will be continually evaluated. We will see which interventions work and do more of them, which interventions have limited success and change them
