

## Folly Hill Infants RE Scheme of Work for KS1

At Folly Hill we follow the Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education in Surrey Schools 2017-22

Religious Education is a legal requirement for all pupils on roll including those in Reception Year. In Foundation Stage there is no specific time requirement but pupils at Folly Hill cover the subject content in ways that best suit links to the early learning goals. See p20 in Agreed Syllabus.

In KS1 pupils are required to study a minimum of 72 hours across the key stage. This included the required 36 hours for Christianity and extends into additional and comparative studies. Units will be taught flexibly and may move at times but each year group will cover the units listed below during the year.
